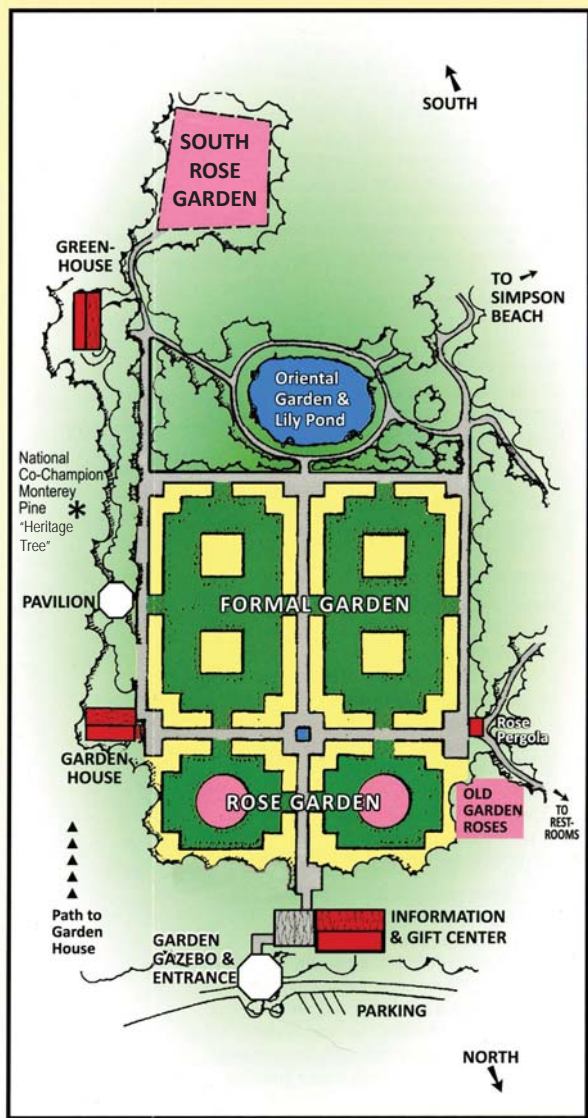

There's something in flower almost any day of the year. Bloom times are based on average weather conditions at Shore Acres.

— Seasonal and Showy Blooms —



Hundreds of spring bulbs and daffodils - late Feb.-Mar.



5,000 tulips – late Mar.-Apr.

Hundreds of rhododendrons and azaleas – Apr.-May



Thousands of flowering annuals – June.-Sept.

800 rose bushes – June-Sept.



250 dahlias – Aug.-Oct.

At least 300,000 Holiday Lights (Mostly L.E.D.) – Thanksgiving thru New Year's Eve
