A community tradition was born in 1987 when Friends of Shore Acres Inc. decided to “string a few lights” to help celebrate the holidays.

That first season, 6,000 miniature lights, one large Christmas tree, and the decorated and open Garden House drew 9,000 visitors.

Now, **at least 325,000 Lights** – both LED and landscape – thirty Christmas trees, dozens of lighted sculptures, performance pavilion, and the festive open house attract – **on average** – from 50,000 to 60,000 visitors each season.

Inside the Garden House, long scrolls of names pay tribute to the business supporters, members, and the more than **1,500** volunteers who make it happen for all to enjoy. •
